Frequently Asked Questions

→ How often can you get new safety glasses?

A: You can get new safety glasses every two years.

→ How long will it take for my glasses to be ready?

A: It should take about a week before your safety glasses are ready.

→ Is there a specific Wisconsin Vision location I need to go to?

A: There is not a specific location you have to go to, but you should go to the location closest to you.

→ Do I have to have a prescription prior?

A: We do not provide prescriptions for you, so you should have your prescription prior to requesting safety glasses.
